Fan Tips

Collecting Funds:

- 1. **Most popular option**: Use our Peer-to-Peer online tool to create YOUR custom Team Fundraising campaign. Click <u>here</u> to start collecting online donations for your team and track your progress.
- 2. Collect cash and checks (make out to Family Eldercare & include team name)
- Family Eldercare is a 501(c)(3) organization. Contributions are tax-deductible to the fullest extent of the law. A cash donor will not receive a tax letter from us unless you pass along their name, contact information and gift amount to us.

Fan Facts

Why is the Summer Fan Drive Important?

- Heat is the #1 weather-related killer.
- For people who are older or health-compromised, heat can be deadly.
- Many of our high-risk neighbors are living without AC.
- They're more likely than others to spend much of their time alone and indoors.
- Having a way to cool off is vital and can be lifesaving.
- Fans only cost 10 cents a day to run.
- Just \$60 provides 3 fans to those in need.

Summer Fan Drive Stats About the People Getting Help

- 34% are 65+.
- 36% live in a hot home with their pet.
- 65% worry about not having enough food to eat.
- 49% have felt sick from the heat.

Frequently Asked Questions

Why do you limit the donation of fans to only new? Won't anything be helpful to those in need?

We get asked this question a lot, and as a Fan Drive Team Captain, you might too. When we distribute an item to someone for use in their home, it's important to limit the potential hazards associated with that item. Used fans may break faster and we want to make sure they last as long as possible.

Why don't you provide Air Conditioners?

We used to provide A/Cs in years past. We've learned that most people we serve through the fan drive can't afford to run an A/C. Some homes are not structurally sound enough to support an AC or window unit.

What if someone got a fan last year? Will they get one again this year?

If someone qualifies for a fan this year, then we provide it even if they received on last year. Since they cannot run their AC, they are running their fans 24/7. This means more wear-and-tear from heavy use. The fans we provide may not necessarily last multiple years.

Who benefits from the Fan Drive?

For over 30 years the fans generated by the Fan Drive have given comfort to low-income older adults, adults with disabilities and families with children. In 2022 we distributed 7,600 fans in 14 Texas counties and their communities. More than 10,200 people benefited from the fans we provided.

How much can a fan really help?

Heat is the #1 weather-related killer, especially among older adults. Fans can save a life by circulating air and cooling off the body. The fan drive also connects us to people who need additional resources. Last year more than 520 referrals were made to fan drive families including food pantry services, utility assistance, grief counseling and more!

Will donors get a tax receipt?

Yes-If your team creates a unique online fundraising link using our Peer-to-Peer tool.

Yes-if your team donates by check.

Yes-If your team donates directly to the Summer Fan Drive donate button.

No-if you create a Peer-to-Peer using a different tool from ours like Go Fund Me

No-if you collect anonymous cash donations.

No-if you create your own Facebook fundraiser.

Maybe-if you respond to our Facebook fundraiser (based on privacy settings and if donation confirmed)
